Begins: February-April

Ends: Mid-October or
Early November

Weather Outlook

much wetter than normal
due to the 2020 El Niño
weather pattern

1. The Southwest has already seen a wetter-than-usual beginning of 2020 due to the El Niño weather pattern.
2. The conditions are supposed to stay like this for the rest of the spring and summer
3. When you pair that with the hot temperatures of the region, mosquito populations are expected to be higher than normal.
4. Mosquito season in the Southwest usually starts around March
5. Mosquito season can last all the way to the end of the year.
6. Temperatures consistently stay above 60 at night in the region well into November & December.
